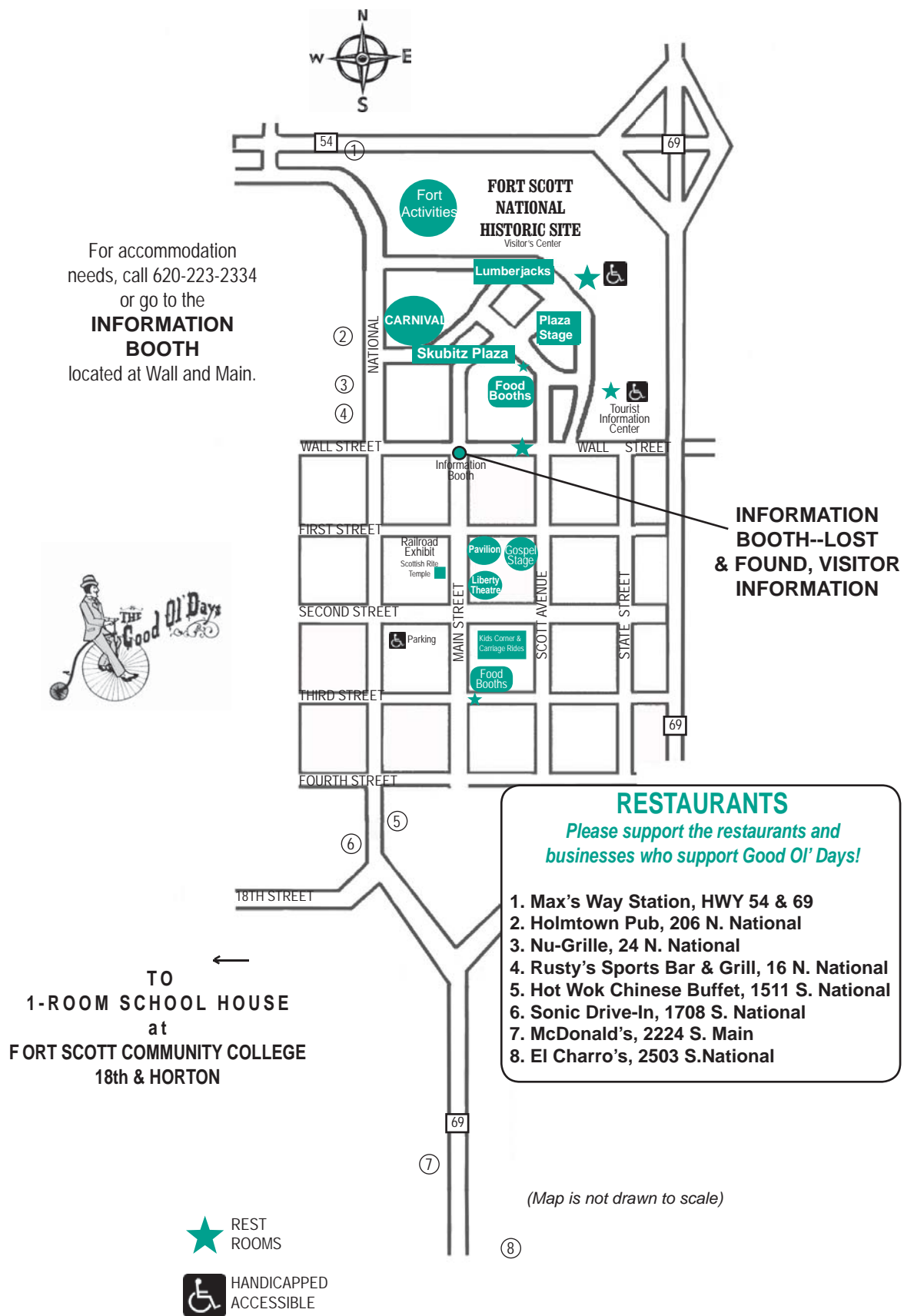

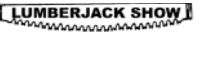
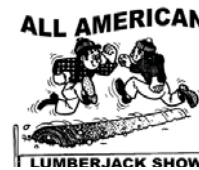

Fort Scott National Historic Site:

From 1842-1873, soldiers of Fort Scott fulfilled various roles set forth by the United States government. Military service men and women before and after have done the same, serving this great nation of ours with pride and distinction. Duty, honor, and service to their country are watchwords that provide links to these elite members of the armed forces. Stroll the grounds and talk to volunteers representing a timeline of soldiers from the American Revolution to the Iraq War. Listen to music spanning two centuries performed by the 4th Artillery Regimental Brass Band and the Friends of Fort Scott Brass. Compare and contrast military vehicles from the 19th Century to today.
