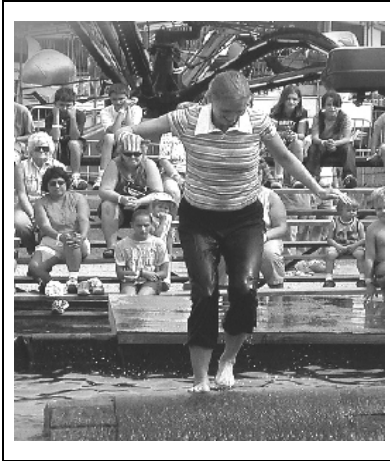




## 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Fort All-American

Horses in 2008, the Good Ol Days special events committee is bringing the lumberjack show to the plaza area in front of the Fort for all day on Saturday and Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.

Lumberjacks opened the land to farms and cities, help build America and became the legends of the forest. The legend lives on in the All-American Lumberjack Show that will feature team events, ten exciting lumberjack events, 10,000 gallons of water and a good time for all.

Kid's Lumberjack Sport Camps are free to all youngsters young and old where the skills of the American Lumberjack are taught. Lumberjack events of X-Cut sawing and Log Rolling will be taught by the pros. Before chain saws were invented, Lumberjacks had Big X- Cut Saws to cut the trees down. It takes two to pull these saws with a person on one end and a partner on the other.

After you worked up a sweat pulling your end of the saw you might want to head on over to the log-rolling tank to try your luck at Log Rolling. Log Rolling was a skill that was needed for lumberjacks that guided the logs down the river in a Log Drive. It's known as the favorite sport of the lumberjack and the most difficult event to learn. Floating in the water is a big lathed-turned log that weighs over 600 pounds and it's your job to stay on top and not fall in. Looks easy but bring a towel because you're going to get wet.

Another event is Chain Saw Carving demonstrations. Chain saws were invented in the early 1950's for the sole purpose of replacing the x-cut saws that were used to cut logs. Since then chain saws have been designed for many more uses including chain saw carving. With light weight saws, special bars, a plain old log and a lot of practice, lumberjacks are able to carve just about anything imaginable including bears, eagles, turtles, fish, cactus, mushrooms, etc. These items will be for sale.
